




Results are detailed in the following graphs. The NZSA will strenuously oppose any moves by companies to diminish the right of all shareholders to attend Annual Meetings, and supports the hybrid physical/virtual option as the best way to achieve broad participation.

1. Question 1 – Have you ever watched a Virtual AGM (via Web Cast) where you can't vote/or ask questions? This could be either live or at a later date.




2. Question 2 – Have you ever participated in a Virtual AGM where you can ask questions/vote?






3. Question 3 – If you answered 'Yes' to 'Question 2. Did you have any technical difficulities: connecting, watching, asking questions or voting?




4. Question 4 – Most preferred option of AGM's.







5. Question 5 – If a company holds a Virtual Meeting but will also hold a Physical Meeting as well. Who do you think should decide what is controversial?








